



## **A Look at our Program Participants**

In Oct 2015 we registered 236 families (711 individuals) into the Share365 program. We define a family as all people living in a household. Therefore a family could be a single person, a couple, a single parent and their children, an inter-generational family. For the registered families the breakdown of their income source is:

- 43% Ontario Works
- 33% Ontario Disability Support Program
- 13% are working
- 9% are on Old Age Security and/or Canada Pension Plan
- 2% income other – mostly through child support payments

In addition, 87% of SHARE365 participants live in high-density neighbourhoods and many struggle with inadequate and precarious housing.

We also know that

- 83 participants are 60 years of age and older
- 276 participants are 19 – 59 years of age
- 352 participants are newborn – 18 years of age
